Historical District Signs

Authorized Signs in the Historical District include, Awning Signs, Marquee Signs, and Wall Signs. The Size of signs in the Historical District may not exceed 36" in Height and the length is limited to 50% the length of the associated building face. Any materials used for signs in the Historical District should have a reasonable degree of consistency and reflect a concern for the visual amenities Within the Historical District. The Historical District is outlined on the map below:



Central Business District Signs

Signs in the Central Business District (C-1) include Awning signs, Marquee signs, Wall signs, Ground signs, Pole signs, Flashing sign (except those which "flash" outside of the message area), and changeable copy signs.

Requirements for wall signs shall be the same as for the Historic District. Ground signs may be placed on parcels having minimum public street frontage of 100 feet and minimum building set back of 25 feet. Ground signs shall have maximum sign area of 50 square feet and height of nine feet. Pole signs may be considered only when because of obstruction of sight lines or for other reasons a ground sign is not feasible. If allowed, pole signs shall have a maximum sign area of 50 square feet and height of ten feet above street level to bottom of sign.

Electronic or digital reader board signs are not allowed in these districts.
